BOARD OF TRANSPORTATION MEETING

October 3, 2019

Call to Order

Chairman Fox called the meeting of the Board of Transportation to order at 9:03 a.m. on Thursday, October 3, 2019, in Raleigh, North Carolina with the following members present in the Board room: Chairman Fox, Vice-Chair Szlosberg-Landis, Overholt, Perkins, Hunt, Alford, Pope, Lathrop, Debnam, Clarke, Cody, Zimmer, and Mathis.

Board Member Moran and Board Member Tulloss called in to the meeting.

Board Members Taft, Jordan, Bowles, and Tarleton were absent.

Ethics Statement

Chairman Fox read the Ethics Statement advising all members of the Board that may have any conflict of interest, or appearance of conflict, to refrain from participation in that particular item and to file the proper paperwork with the Secretary to the Board of Transportation.

Approval – September 5, 2019 Board Meeting Minutes

Chairman Fox stated that the meeting minutes were distributed for review prior to the meeting. Chairman Fox stated if there are no additions or corrections, he would accept a motion to approve the meeting minutes from the September 5, 2019 Board of Transportation meeting. The meeting minutes were unanimously approved by the Board following a motion made by Board Member Lathrop and a second by Board Member Zimmer.

Road, Bridge and Ferry Naming Honorary Designations

Board Member Mathis presented a resolution naming the N.C. 24/27 bridge over Little River in Montgomery County as the Corporal Henry F Warner Bridge. The resolution was unanimously approved by the Board upon a motion by Board Member Mathis and seconded by Board Member Perkins. (A copy of the resolution is at the end of this document).

Secretary's Remarks

Secretary Trogdon shared information on Hurricane Dorian damage throughout the state. He stated that Hurricane Dorian caused damage in a few areas in the eastern part of the state, including significant flooding (7 feet) on Ocracoke Island. Secretary Trogdon mentioned the latest estimate on costs to NCDOT infrastructure were \$40 million. The worst damage to a single site was the 1,000-foot washout of N.C. 12 on Ocracoke. He stated that the Department is doing all they can to restore this critical lifeline for the island and the Outer Banks as soon as possible. Secretary Trogdon stated that the Department was awarded a \$1.77 emergency contract in hopes of having the roads repaired before Thanksgiving. Secretary Trogdon mentioned the Department is focused on helping affected communities recover from Dorian, he shared we are fortunate the storm had fewer statewide impacts compared to other recent hurricanes.

U.S. 421

Secretary Trogdon shared that days after the storm cleared from the coast, he joined the governor and other officials for an event at the Pender-New Hanover county line. While attending the event Secretary Trogdon shared an update on Hurricane Dorian and also recognized the one-year anniversary of Hurricane Florence. The event was held on U.S. 421 where the worst washout from Florence occurred, because it is a prime example of this resilient focus. The new design replaces a single culvert with a pair of two-lane bridges constructed to withstand another Florence-caliber storm.

Karen Collette

Secretary Trogdon acknowledged Karen Collette, Division Three Engineer, who is retiring November 29, 2019. Secretary Trogdon shared he had the privilege of meeting both the first female licensed professional engineer in North Carolina, Emily Blount, and the state's first and to this point only female division engineer, Karen. Secretary Trogdon stated Karen has been a strong and knowledgeable leader. He shared that we will have big shoes to fill. Karen graduated from N.C. State in 1988, she worked her first 23 years in maintenance and construction roles, including assistant district engineer, county maintenance engineer, district engineer and resident engineer. In 2012, she was named the division engineer for the Wilmington area, which allowed her to move back to her hometown. Secretary Trogdon congratulated Karen on her outstanding career and wished her the very best in retirement.

Event Updates

Secretary Trogdon shared that on September 10th he met with the Wilmington Chamber of Commerce's Regional Transportation Advocacy Group. He also, shared he attended the AASHTO Council of Rail Transportation, held Sept. 16-19 in Hartford, Conn., where discussion included federal spending on passenger rail, agency/private freight rail coordination, and future grant opportunities.

Cash Balance

Secretary Trogdon mentioned the Department continues to monitor the cash balance very closely and are working very hard to stay above the cash floor. He stated they are controlling what they can, adjusting our spending as needed to ensure we remain in good standing. The next two months are critical for the Department.

Zero Emission Vehicle (ZEV) Plan

Secretary Trogdon shared the Department released the ZEV Plan for accelerating the adoption of electric vehicles in North Carolina. The plan was presented to Governor Cooper and members of the N.C. Climate Change Interagency Council. This plan is the direct result of the governor's executive order that calls for addressing climate change by reducing emissions and growing clean energy. More ZEVs will translate to a reduction in emissions. This plan sets a goal of 80,000 ZEVs in North Carolina by 2025. Secretary Trogdon mentioned here at NCDOT, we understand the value of preparing for and leveraging disruptive technologies like battery-electric vehicles and that is why this plan is important for us and will serve us well as the industry changes faster than ever before.

Complete 540

Secretary Trogdon stated the Department is moving forward on the project to Complete 540, working toward a groundbreaking event for this fall. Two of three contracts have been awarded and construction is set to begin later this year. The tentative completion date for the first phase, from N.C. 55 Bypass to I-40, is 2023.

GTP Executive Director

Secretary Trogdon acknowledged John Rouse, who has been serving as Global TransPark interim executive director of the Kinston facility since May, has accepted the position in a permanent roll. This is a fitting move, as John is a Lenoir County native and has years of experience overseeing our divisions in eastern North Carolina.

Awards

Secretary Trogdon shared that the Department received several awards in the past month and is vying for more. The 2019 Mobi Awards, which recognize and promote investments in multimodal transportation projects, earned an Impact Award from the National Association of Development Organizations. The National Association of State Aviation Officials named NCDOT's drone program as the 2019 Most Innovative State Program at its annual convention a few weeks ago. He mentioned there's also still time to vote for the Department's use of drone technology after Hurricane Florence. NCDOT is nominated for an America's Transportation Award. People can vote once per day, per device, every day until the competition closes at midnight on Oct. 6 by going to bit.ly/voteDOT.

DELEGATED AUTHORITY ITEMS

Approval – Award of Highway Construction Contracts in August 2019 Letting

Chairman Fox stated that items C, D, E, H, and L are delegated to the Secretary and require no formal action by the Board. He shared that for Item C: All projects were awarded by the Secretary to the low bidder.

Complete 540 Update

Daniel Johnson, NCDOT General Counsel provided an update on the Complete 540 project including the timeline associated with the contract awards and construction start. He shared the tentative completion date for the first phase, from N.C. 55 Bypass to I-40, is 2023.

Closed Session: Pursuant to NC General Statute §143-318.11(a)(3)

Chairman Fox called for a motion to move into closed session per North Carolina General Statute 143-318.11 to "consult with an attorney . . . in order to preserve the attorney-client privilege between the attorney and the public body" as permitted pursuant to subsection (a)(3).

Board member Clarke made a motion to enter into closed session, seconded by Board member Cody. The Board voted unanimously to enter into closed session.

Chairman Fox called the closed session to order.

The open session resumed following the closed session. The doors to the meeting room were opened; all NCDOT staff and guests were invited to return to the meeting room. Chairman Fox noted the meeting was formally back in open session. Chairman Fox stated for the record that no votes were taken in closed session. Chairman Fox continued the meeting agenda in open session.

Approval of Projects

A motion was made by Board Member Debnam and seconded by Board Member Pope to approve all projects for items G, I-1, I-1A, I-4, K, M, N, O, P, R, S, and T. (excluding items C, D, E, H, and L as they are delegated authority items and require no formal board action).

Board Member Alford recused himself from voting on the following project item:

 Item O – Project Y-5500GC 80000.2.2.7 City of Mebane, Norfolk Southern Railroad (NS), North Carolina Railroad Company (NCRR), Alamance County; This Rail Agreement provides for the implementation of the near-term and mid-term rail safety recommendations of the Mebane Traffic Separation Study executed by the Department and the Municipality on June 4, 2018. The Department will prepare the project plans and the environmental documentation and construct the improvements outside of the railroad right-of-way. NS shall perform all work within their right-of-way. The estimated project cost is \$1,000,000.

Board Member Zimmer recused himself from voting on the following project items:

- Item K-1 Project U-4751; Wilmington/New Hanover Co. Div. 3; WBS 40191.1.2; SR 1409 (Military Cutoff Road Extension) from SR 1409 (Military Cutoff Road) to US 17 in Wilmington. \$10,450,302.00 has previously been approved for preliminary engineering. Additional funds are needed to cover expenditures that have exceeded the previously authorized budget. This project has previously been identified as a Trust Fund Intrastate System project.
- Item M-7 Project C-5555E EXEMPT; Guilford Co.; 45540.2.6, CMS-1546(021); SR 1546 (College Road) and SR 2179 (New Garden Road) in Greensboro. \$145,369.00 has previously been approved for right of way and utilities. Additional funds are needed as requested.

 Item O – Project U-4751; 40191.3.2; Tri-City Butte, LLC New Hanover County; This Project consists of an additional exclusive eastbound right-turn lane on SR 2892 (Lendire Road) at the intersection with US 17 (Market Street) as requested by the Developer in conjunction with the Department's U-4751 Project. The Developer shall reimburse the Department 100% for the work. The estimated reimbursement is \$100,000.

Board Member Lathrop recused himself from voting on the following project items:

- Item M-12 Project B-5809; Anson Co.; 45763.2.1, BRZ-1142(012); Replace Bridge #75 over North Fork Jones Creek on SR 1142. Funds are needed for full right of way and utilities.
- Item M-13 Project R-5790JF; Divisionwide; 44920.3.14, TAP-00SS(060); ADA Ramps (Americans with Disabilities Act) for areas with populations < 5,000 in Cabarrus, Anson and Stanly Counties. Funds are needed for construction to install curb ramps and retrofit existing ramps.
- Item N Project W-5810DIV; ANSON; SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS AT VARIOUS LOCATIONS IN DIVISION 10. ADD RIGHT-OF-WAY AND CONSTRUCTION NOT PREVIOUSLY PROGRAMMED.
- Item N Project W-5810REG; ANSON; SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS AT VARIOUS LOCATIONS IN DIVISION 10. ADD RIGHT-OF-WAY AND CONSTRUCTION NOT PREVIOUSLY PROGRAMMED.
- Item N Project W-5810SW; ANSON; SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS AT VARIOUS LOCATIONS IN DIVISION 10. ADD RIGHT-OF-WAY AND CONSTRUCTION NOT PREVIOUSLY PROGRAMMED.
- Item O Project C-5601F and G 50062.5.1; Wake County, North Carolina State University, Clean Energy Technology Center (CETC); This Project consists of the development and operation of a clean fuel advanced technology outreach and awareness program, including sub-awards for projects in eligible counties in North Carolina. The Project will be administered by the Clean Energy Technology Center (CETC) at NC State University. The Department shall reimburse 80% from CMAQ funds, not to exceed \$2,335,132. The CETC will be responsible for the 20% (\$583,783) nonfederal match for the CMAQ funds authorized and all costs that exceed the total available funding of \$2,918,915.
- Item O Project U-5905; 46450.1.1, 46450.2.1, 46450.3.1, City of Charlotte Mecklenburg County; This Project consists of improvements along Lakeview Road (SR

2112) from Old Statesville Road (US 21) to Reames Road (SR 2110). The Municipality is responsible for the project. The Department's original participation was \$11,000,000 in State Bonus Allocation funds. The Department has agreed to participate in additional project costs with federal funds. The Department shall reimburse 80% of eligible expenses up to \$3,823,000. The Municipality will provide a 20% non-federal match of \$955,750 and all costs that exceed the total available funding of \$15,778,750.

- Item O Project EB-5748, 50425.1.1; City of Mount Holly Gaston County; This Project consists of the construction of new sidewalk on SR 2439 (Beaty Road) from Smith Street to Ferstl Avenue. The Department shall prepare the preliminary engineering plans and participate in 80% (\$81,000) of the PE costs from federal funds. The Municipality will provide a 20% (\$20,250) non-federal match and all costs that exceed the total available funding of \$101,250.
- Item O Project EB-5912, 47578.1.1; City of Mount Holly Gaston County; This Project consists of the construction of new sidewalk along the south side of SR 2044 (Tuckaseege Road). The Department shall prepare the preliminary engineering plans and participate in 80% (\$230,000) of the PE costs from federal funds. The Municipality will provide a 20% (\$57,500) non-federal match and all costs that exceed the total available funding of \$287,500.

At the time of preparation of this agenda item the General Assembly had ratified Senate Bill 966 but, it was not yet Session Law. Accordingly, it is recommended to move forward with a partial allocation of General Maintenance Reserve, Roadside Environmental, Contract Resurfacing, Pavement Preservation, Bridge Program, and Bridge Preservation funds. The initial allocation was determined by calculating a 6-month Division spend plan based on the previous year's distribution formulas assuming roughly half of the anticipated total allocation for FY 2020. SCHEDULE I – GENERAL MAINTENANCE RESERVE

In accordance with the recommended allocations listed on Page 1, a total of \$252,000,000 has been made available for distribution. It is recommended to continue to cash flow \$250,194,866 equally among the 14 Highway Divisions. The funds allocated will be used for Road and Bridge Maintenance, as well as support Division Administration and Enterprise level programs.

ROAD AND BRIDGE MAINTENANCE

This item, listed under General Maintenance Reserve, will be utilized for the purposes of continuing routine maintenance activities including, but not limited to, pavement patching, pavement markings, markers, signs, symbols, roadside vegetation management, drainage, unpaved shoulders, litter pickup, and other similar maintenance activities. Bridge related activities include, but are not limited to, repairing concrete bridge decks, girder painting, emergency bridge repair or replacement, foundation repair, installation of support bents, and flooring and rail repair. Replacing small critical bridges and pipes are also eligible activities. and These expenditures will include both contract and force account maintenance.

DIVISION ADMINISTRATION

Division Administration is a direct allocation to the Divisions for the estimated cost of the following:

- Traffic System Operations
- Incident Management
- Electricity for Traffic Control Devices
- Maintenance of Roadway and Interchange Lighting
- Major Events
- Maintenance and Repair of Guardrail
- Operation of Moveable Span Bridges
- River Ferries

ENTERPRISE PROGRAMS

Enterprise level programs are comprised of four main categories: **State and Federal Obligations, Asset Maintenance and Operations, Research and Development, and Emergencies**.

State and Federal Obligations are funds required either by state or federal laws, regulations or rules. Examples of such obligations include Asphalt Testing Labs Corrective Actions, Drug & Alcohol Testing, Railroad Signal Maintenance, and maintenance of Weigh Stations.

Asset Maintenance and Operations are funds used to assess and address statewide program needs. Examples include funding the central activities related to Incident Management, Materials and Test non-TIP pavement activities, NPDES functions, and maintenance repairs to assets such as traffic signals.

Research and Development are funds used to research, develop, and implement state of the art maintenance technologies, practices and procedures. Objectives of these programs include improving maintenance efficiencies and improving cost effectiveness.

Emergencies are funds used for weather related events, to cover unanticipated expenditures for non-declared emergency operations, as well as snow and ice equipment purchases.

SCHEDULE II – ROADSIDE ENVIRONMENTAL

Beginning in FY 2018, the General Assembly established funds to be utilized for vegetation management, mowing, litter prevention and removal, beautification efforts, and rest areas. Of the total \$44,941,500 available, the staff recommends continuing to cash flow \$20,000,000 equally in each of the 14 Highway Divisions and is included in the allocation figures. These funds will be used for Roadside Maintenance, as well as support Division Administration and Enterprise level programs.

The staff recommends a direct allocation to the Divisions for the estimated cost of the following Division Administration activities:

- Specialized Landscaping
- Rest Areas and Welcome Centers

The staff also recommends allocating \$4,500,000 to Asset Maintenance and Operation for activities such as monitoring contract Litter and Mowing efforts and renovation and repair of Rest Areas.

Further detail regarding recommended allocations of these funds is addressed in Table 1 on Page 4.

SCHEDULE III – CONTRACT RESURFACING

Of the total \$225,675,000 available, the staff recommends continuing to cash flow \$178,000,000 equally in each of the 14 Highway Divisions which is included in the allocation numbers. Resurfacing activities will include placement of plant mixed asphalt, surface treatment seals, and recycling existing pavement. They will also include surface preparation, shoulder reconstruction, and traffic lane markings, performed by State Forces and by Contract. In accordance with current legislation, up to 15% of the funds may be used for widening existing narrow pavements. It is also recommended that, of the total funds available, \$50,000 be allocated to Asset Maintenance and Operation to cover non-TIP Materials & Test activity overdrafts. The remaining \$225,625,000 is to be distributed among the 14 Divisions.

SCHEDULE IV – PAVEMENT PRESERVATION

Beginning in FY 2015, the General Assembly has provided funds to address preservation activities or treatments for asphalt pavement structures. Eligible activities include the following: chip seals, slurry seals, fog seals, sand seals, scrub seals, and cape seals. Microsurfacing, profile milling not covered by resurfacing, asphalt rejuvenators, and open graded asphalt friction course is also eligible. Additional preservation activities include overlays less than 1,000 feet in length, diamond grinding, joint sealing, dowel bar retrofit, and partial or full depth repairs and reclamations. Ultra-thin whitetopping, thin lift and sand asphalt overlays and asphalt crack sealing are also eligible pavement preservation activities. Session Law 2017-57 expanded eligible activities to include pavement markers and markings. Of the \$35,625,000 available, it is recommended to continue cash flowing \$15,000,000 which will be distributed equally among each of the 14 Highway Divisions. These figures are included in the allocation amounts.

SCHEDULE V – BRIDGE PROGRAM

Beginning in FY 2015, the General Assembly established Bridge Program funds which are intended to address structurally deficient bridges. Of the total \$83,125,000 available, staff recommends continuing to cash flow \$20,000,000 equally among each of the 14 Highway Divisions which is included in the allocation figures. It is recommended that \$49,875,000 be allocated to fund construction costs for SFY 2020 bridge projects and to fund preliminary engineering costs for future bridge projects on the Primary System leaving \$33,250,000 to be distributed among the Divisions.

SCHEDULE VI – BRIDGE PRESERVATION

Beginning in FY 2018, the General Assembly established funds to employ cost effective solutions to maximize bridge life and lower lifetime cost. Of the \$35,625,000 total available funds, it is recommended that \$17,812,500 be allocated statewide for high value bridge preservation projects. The staff also recommends allocating a total of \$532,000 among Divisions 1, 2, and 3 for the maintenance of moveable span bridges. The remaining \$17,280,500 is recommended to be distributed to the Divisions.

Further detail regarding recommended allocations of these funds is addressed in Table 2 on Page 6.





PRODUCT HIGHLIGHT – Flex Guard®



Flex Guard is a hydraulically applied Fiber Reinforced Matrix (FRM) that is manufactured by Mat, Inc. and is currently being evaluated for inclusion on the Approved Products List. Flex Guard[®] is a hydromulch that is engineered with pasteurized wood fibers, dispersible synthetic fibers, and various soil bonding agents (Crosslinked Hydro-colloid Tackifiers and Activators). Once the mixture of FRM, soil, and seeds cures; the new surface is bonded to the soil, and forms a flexible, absorbent, and continuous erosion blanket. Flex Guard[®] reduces sediment run-off by almost 99%. The longevity of the mixture lasts between 18 and 24 months depending upon slope angle, climate, and application rate of the FRM. The typical application rate for Flex Guard[®] is approximately 3,000 pounds per acre for a 3H to 1V slope.

PRODUCT INNOVATION – Continuous Flow Intersection

A continuous flow intersections (CFI) uses left turn crossovers prior to the main intersection, so that at the main intersection left turns do not hold up all other users. There are about 30 CFIs open across the US. NC's first CFI is scheduled to open before the end of 2019 on NC-16 just north of I-485 in northwest Mecklenburg County. A CFI provides the highest traffic capacity of any known at-grade intersection design. Its capacity is so high that it competes well with much more expensive and impactful interchange alternatives. A case where a CFI was chosen over an interchange is on TIP Project U-5744 in Garner, at US-70 and Timber Drive. The U-5744 project public meeting map (a portion of which is included to the left) shows a good plan view of a CFI. Several other CFIs are in the planning and design stages around the state. CFIs are a great addition to the intersection design toolkit to allow project teams to move more traffic through smaller spaces safely and efficiently in a costeffective way. NCDOT also has two ongoing research projects that are developing new alternative interchange designs and their associated signings and marking (RP2019-26 and RP2018-20).
