





Monthly Transponders Sold






YTD revenues 37.0% higher than financing base case projections







Volvo Trucks/FedEx Platooning

AVPG Designation



- Triangle Expressway designated as a USDOT Autonomous Vehicle Proving Ground in January 2017
- First meeting with Volvo Trucks team in March 2017
- Collaborated with Volvo team, NCDOT and NCDMV on platooning legislation that was passed in July 2017
- Volvo submitted a plan for demonstration in March 2018
- Ordinances issued by NCDOT March 29, 2018
- Demonstration began in early April 2018

Details of Demonstration

- Veridea Parkway served as the proving ground and southern terminus of route
- Davis/Hopson interchange was used as northern terminus of route
- Salt barn location at Green Level was used to store tractors/trailers overnight
- Demonstration occurred outside a.m. and p.m. peak periods
- Trucks were spaced 75 to 100 feet apart as they traveled at
 62 miles per hour
- All tractors had licensed drivers, each with 15+ years driving experience
