

Our Work in Division 2

MAJOR PROJECTS COMPLETED IN 2020

C.F. HARVEY PARKWAY EXTENSION (LENOIR COUNTY)

- ⇒ Extends C.F. Harvey Parkway by 5.8 miles
- ⇒ Connectivity improving in northern Kinston from N.C. 58, N.C. 11 and U.S. 70

SLOCUM GATE (CRAVEN COUNTY)

- ⇒ Overpass over U.S. 70 into Slocum Gate at MCAS Cherry Point
- ⇒ Reduces congestion and delays for motorists making left turns from U.S. 70 East

NORTH RIVER BRIDGE (CARTERET COUNTY)

- ⇒ New bridge spans 1,000 feet over North River
- ⇒ Old bridge demolished

U.S. 264 / FUTURE I-587 (PITT AND GREENE COUNTIES)

Upgrading U.S. 264 to freeway standards and resurfacing 18 miles from Greenville to Wilson County

U.S. 70 / FUTURE I-42 (CRAVEN AND JONES COUNTIES)

- ⇒ Upgrading U.S. 70 to freeway standards and surfacing 32 miles from Dover to New Bern
- ⇒ Substantially complete in late 2020

MAJOR PROJECTS UNDERWAY IN 2021

U.S. 70 JAMES CITY (CRAVEN COUNTY)

- ⇒ Part of improvements to upgrade to Interstate 42
- ⇒ Existing traffic signal will be eliminated
- ⇒ Construction expected to begin in 2021

HAVELOCK BYPASS (CRAVEN COUNTY)

- ⇒ Bypass on the southwest side of Havelock and U.S. 70 beginning north of the Havelock city limit and extending south approximately 10 miles to just south of the Craven-Carteret county line
- ⇒ Improve traffic and freight movement along the U.S. 70 Corridor
- ⇒ Construction expected to be complete in 2024

The Coming Decade

The State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) lays out the N.C. Department of Transportation's plan for transportation projects during the next 10 years. The STIP is updated approximately every two years. The 2020-2029 STIP includes 121 projects in Division 2. Among the improvements planned are:

- ⇒ In Carteret County, install roundabouts on N.C. 58 (Emerald Drive) at Loon Street, Coast Guard Road and Mangrove Drive. Construction starts in 2027.
- ⇒ In Craven County, upgrade U.S. 70 to a freeway between Havelock Bypass to East of Thurman Road. Construction expected to start in late 2021-22.
- ⇒ In Lenoir County, build the 22-mile U.S. 70 Kinston Bypass between LaGrange and Dover, as part of the future Interstate 42. Construction is scheduled to start in 2029.

C.F. HARVEY PARKWAY EXTENSION COMPLETE

C.F. Harvey Parkway (N.C. 148) was extended by 5.8 miles from N.C. 58 to N.C. 11 north of Kinston. The new route is expected to improve connectivity in northern Kinston between U.S. 70, N.C. 58 and N.C. 11. The project was completed in late 2020, ahead of schedule.

SLOCUM GATE COMPLETE

The N.C. Department of Transportation began building the overpass over U.S. 70 in August 2017 and it was completed in 2020. The \$24.4 million project will reduce traffic congestion and improve safety between drivers on the highway and drivers entering and exiting MCAS Cherry Point at Slocum Gate.
