



# OUR WORK IN DIVISION 8

## MAJOR PROJECTS COMPLETED IN 2019

### **N.C. 24/27 TROY BYPASS (MONTGOMERY COUNTY)**

- ⇒ 6.6-mile bypass follows a new route south of Troy, reducing traffic on the two-lane route through town
- ⇒ 55-mph speed limit, a divided median and four traffic signals, plus an interchange at Troy Candor Road

### **MIDLAND ROAD ROUNDABOUT (MOORE COUNTY)**

- ⇒ Improved safety and reduces congestion at Midland Road (N.C. 2) and Central Drive (N.C. 22)
- ⇒ Included interchange improvement at nearby U.S. 1 in Southern Pines that adds reduced-conflict design – safer and more efficient with medians directing people to turn right off U.S. 1

## MAJOR PROJECTS UNDERWAY IN 2020

### **U.S. 64 ASHEBORO BYPASS (RANDOLPH COUNTY)**

- ⇒ A 16.4-mile bypass under a \$244 million construction contract awarded in 2015; opening scheduled for late 2020
- ⇒ Addresses congestion, travel delays and high crash rates on U.S. 64 through Asheboro
- ⇒ Part of plan to upgrade key corridors from Statesville to Raleigh (U.S. 64) and Charlotte to Raleigh (N.C. 49 and U.S. 64)

### **I-73/I-74 ROCKINGHAM BYPASS (RICHMOND COUNTY)**

- ⇒ A 7.2-mile, four-lane, median-divided freeway on new location
- ⇒ Existing U.S. 74 Rockingham Bypass will be upgraded between Zion Church Road and U.S. 74 Business interchange to six lanes with a 60-foot median with new interchanges

### **U.S. 1 WIDENING (RICHMOND COUNTY)**

- ⇒ Widening 3.5 miles of U.S. 1 between Fox Road and Marsten Road
- ⇒ Will improve mobility by adding a travel lane in each direction on the highway east of Rockingham, with completion scheduled in 2021

# 2020 & THE COMING DECADE

The State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) lays out the N.C. Department of Transportation's plan for transportation projects during the next 10 years. The STIP is updated approximately every two years. The 2020-2029 STIP includes **115** projects in Division 8. Among the improvements planned are:

- ⇒ In Lee County, extend Commerce Drive to create a new intersection with Lee Avenue in Sanford, with construction to start in 2027.
- ⇒ In Moore County, widen U.S. 15/501 between N.C. 2 and N.C. 73 in Pinehurst, with construction to start in 2027.
- ⇒ In Randolph County, widen N.C. 49 between Waynick Meadow Road and Old N.C. 49 in Asheboro, with construction to start in 2029.
- ⇒ In Richmond and Scotland counties, convert nearly 10 miles of U.S. 74 to interstate standards between Hamlet and Laurinburg, with construction to start in 2029.
- ⇒ In Moore County, reconstruct the intersection of U.S. 15/501 and Morganton Road into an interchange with a bridge, with construction to start in 2029.



## SCHEDULING FOR GOLF TOURNAMENTS

NCDOT is adjusting construction project schedules around the 2022 U.S. Women's Open at Pine Needles Lodge & Golf Club in Southern Pines and the 2024 U.S. Open at Pinehurst Resort & Country Club. The goal is to avoid disrupting traffic routes, buses, business access and overall area preparation for these major sporting events. Projects with adjusted schedules involve U.S. 1, U.S. 15-501, N.C. 211, N.C. 24-27 and N.C. 5 in Moore County.

Drivers traveling in Randolph County will have a faster and safer way to get around Asheboro, thanks to a 16.4-mile bypass under construction. The four-lane highway on the south side of the city is expected to open to traffic in late 2020. The project includes a 1.8-mile connector to improve access to the N.C. Zoo.

## NEW WAY TO TRAVEL AROUND TROY

Travel in Montgomery County is safer and more efficient, thanks to the 2019 opening of the 6.6-mile Troy Bypass. In addition to taking N.C. 24/27 through traffic out of downtown Troy, the bypass features an innovative design known as a reduced-conflict intersection to improve safety and move people on the bypass more quickly. Drivers entering from side roads are directed to turn right onto the bypass. If they want to cross it or travel in the opposite direction, they use a dedicated lane to make a safe U-turn.


