**Part 5: SPECIAL MOBILE EQUIPMENT DEFINED**

A vehicle that has a permanently attached crane, mill, well-boring apparatus, air compressor, electric welder, feed mixer, grinder, or other similar apparatus, is driven on the highway only to get to and from a non-highway job and is not designed or used primarily for the transportation of person or property. A vehicle that has permanently attached special equipment and is used only for parade purposes. A vehicle that is privately owned has permanently attached playground equipment and is used only for playground purposes.

Special mobile equipment may tow any of the following vehicles: A single passenger vehicle that can carry no more than nine passengers and is not loaded, in whole or in part, with passengers or property. A single property-hauling vehicle that has a registered weight of 5,000 pounds or less is not loaded in whole or in part, with passengers or property, General Statute 20- 140.5.
