TEEN DRIVER LEVEL 1 Checklist



If you are 15 to 17 years old and have a Driving Eligibility Certificate and Driver's Education Certificate, you are eligible for a Limited Learner Permit. Here's what to bring to the DMV:

To prove your identity, bring:

- One document proving North Carolina residency (two are required if getting an NC REAL ID)
- Social security card or one document proving you have a Social Security Number
- One document proving North Carolina residency
- Driver Eligibility Certificate (issued by your school)
- Driver's Education Certificate (issued by your driver education school)

Additional details:

You will need to pass written, sign and vision tests.

You must have a parent or guardian present for these tests. Anyone other than the parent or guardian must provide written documentation from a parent or guardian giving consent.

Your Limited Learner Permit will arrive in the mail within 20 business days. Applicants receive a temporary driving certificate to use until their permit arrives.

There is a \$25.50 fee to obtain a level 1 limited learner permit.
