

TEEN DRIVER LEVEL 3

Checklist



Looking for a Full Provisional License? Here's what's required and what you'll need to bring to the DMV.

You must meet the following requirements:

- Be 16 to 17 years old
- Maintained a limited provisional license for at least six months
- Have no convictions of motor vehicle moving violations or seat belt/mobile telephone infractions within the last six months

To prove your identity, bring:

- Your current Limited Provisional License
- A parent or guardian to help you complete the upgrade

Additional details:

Your Full Provisional License will arrive in the mail within 20 business days. Applicants receive a temporary driving certificate to use until their license arrives.

If you are 16 years old, there is a \$32.50 fee to obtain a level 3 full provisional license.

If you are 17 years old, there is a \$26 fee to obtain a level 3 full provisional license.
