Approximately 6-8 weeks prior to the beginning of the class I will mail out information packets. There is a short application you will need to fill out and turn in with your \$250.00 for the class. The class is filled on a first come, first served basis. There is a class limit of twenty students.

The qualifications are as follows:

- Have at least four years' experience as a licensed operator of a motor vehicle.
- Have not been convicted of a felony, or convicted of a misdemeanor involving moral turpitude, in the ten years immediately preceding the date of application.
- Not have had a revocation or suspension of his driver license in the five years immediately preceding the date of application.
- Have graduated from high school or hold a high school equivalency certificate.
- Not have had convictions for moving violations totaling five or more points in the three years preceding the date of application.
