

NCDOT TO HOLD PUBLIC MEETING FEB. 11 IN GREENVILLE FOR THE PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS TO DICKINSON AVENUE FROM MEMORIAL DRIVE TO READE CIRCLE

The N.C. Department of Transportation and the City of Greenville propose to improve Dickinson Avenue (S.R. 1598) from Memorial Drive (N.C. 11) to Reade Circle (S.R. 1610) in Greenville. NCDOT and the City will hold a meeting to provide information about the project to the public on **Tuesday, Feb. 11** from **4 – 7 p.m.** at **Sheppard Memorial Library** located at **530 Evans Street** in **Greenville**.

Interested citizens may attend at any time during the meeting hours, as there will be no formal presentation. Staff from NCDOT and the City of Greenville will be available to discuss the project, answer questions, and receive comments. Citizens will also have the opportunity to submit comments and questions in writing. The comments and information received will be taken into consideration as the project develops.
