

NOTICE OF CITIZENS INFORMATIONAL WORKSHOP FOR THE  
PROPOSED INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS AT U.S. 15-501 BUSINESS (UNIVERSITY  
DRIVE) AND SUMMIT STREET/FORESTWOOD DRIVE

The North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) proposes to make safety improvements at the intersections of U.S. 15-501 Business and Summit St./Forestwood Dr. in Durham. The two roads currently intersect with U.S. 15-501 Business in what is referred to as a “K-type” intersection, with both intersecting from the same side and location. The proposed improvements include a realignment to create separate intersections for each road with U.S. 15-501 Business to improve the safety at this location.

NCDOT will hold a Citizens Informational Workshop for the above-mentioned project on Thursday, March 14, 2013, from 5 to 7 p.m. at the Forest Hills Country Club, located at 1639 University Dr. in Durham.

Interested individuals may attend this informal workshop any time during the above hours. NCDOT representatives will display maps and be available to answer questions and receive comments, which will be taken into consideration as work on the project develops. Please note that there will not be a formal presentation.
