

NCDOT TO HOLD PUBLIC HEARING IN MAY ON PROPOSED RULE CHANGE TO  
NORTH CAROLINA ADMINISTRATIVE CODE REGARDING LOGO SIGNS

The North Carolina Department of Transportation will hold a public hearing on May 20, at 5:00 p.m. at the Chavis Community Center, Community Room, 505 Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard, Raleigh.

This hearing is being held to solicit comments on the proposed change to Title 19A of the North Carolina Administrative Code, Chapter 02, Subchapter E, Part 0219 (19A NCAC 02E.0219).

The proposed rule change would allow attraction facilities that do not meet the hours and days of operations an opportunity, under a provisional contract, to participate in the NCDOT Logo Program when there is room on a sign.
