

NCDOT TO HOLD PUBLIC HEARING IN MAY ON PROPOSED RULE CHANGES
TO THE NORTH CAROLINA ADMINISTRATIVE CODE

The North Carolina Department of Transportation will hold a public hearing on May 20, at 6:30 p.m. at the Chavis Community Center, Community Room, 505 Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard, Raleigh.

This hearing is being held to solicit comments on the proposed change to Title 19A, of the North Carolina Administrative Code, Chapter 02, Subchapter E, Parts 0702 and 0703 (19A NCAC 02E.0702, 0703). The proposed rule change would revise the requirements for solicitation and award of contracts, and codification of prequalifying to award for professional services firms to be consistent with legislative changes and internal policies.
