The North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) will hold two Public Meetings for the above-mentioned railroad/highway project which includes several public railroad crossings in Wilmington. The Meetings will be held on Monday, June 9, 2014 and Tuesday, June 10, 2014, between 5 p.m. and 7 p.m. at the Wilmington Community Center located at 401 South 8th Street, Wilmington.

NCDOT representatives will be present to answer questions and receive comments on the type and frequency of use of various railroad crossings in Wilmington. The opportunity to submit written comments or questions will be provided and is encouraged. Interested citizens may attend at any time. There will not be a formal presentation.

The purpose of the upcoming workshop is to gather information on how and when the public uses the existing at-grade railroad crossings in various locations throughout Wilmington. Citizens are encouraged to provide comments and suggestions related to the crossings. No recommendations are being made at this time.

The goal of NCDOT is to ensure the safety of passengers and train crews, motorists, bicyclists, pedestrians, and the surrounding communities.
