The North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) will hold two Citizen Informational Workshops for the above-mentioned proposed highway project. These will each be held from 4 p.m. to 7 p.m. on the following dates and locations:

NCDOT representatives will be available to speak one on one with citizens, answer questions, and gather public input regarding the proposed project. The opportunity to submit written comments or questions will be provided and is encouraged. The comments and suggestions received will be considered during the planning process. Citizens may attend at any time during the meeting. There will not be a formal presentation. The same information will be available at each workshop.

NCDOT proposes to widen a 10.75 mile segment of US 70 (Burlington Road/South Church Street) from Mount Hope Church Road (State Road 3045) in Guilford County to Westbrook Avenue (State Road 1309) in Alamance County. The proposed widening will include a four lane divided roadway that will tie into the existing roads. The purpose of this project is to improve traffic flow and traffic carrying capacity. Additional right-of-way acquisition and the relocation of homes and businesses will be required for this project.
