



Capital Boulevard Bridge Replacement Projects

Transportation Improvement Program Project No. B-5121/B-5317

Public Meeting Scheduled for November 19

NCDOT proposes to replace two bridges along Capital Boulevard, at Peace Street and at Wade Avenue. Public meetings have been held previously in September 2011 and October 2012. Since the last meeting, the interchange alternatives have been modified. Currently, two designs are being considered at each interchange. The purpose of this public meeting is to present the current designs to the public. Businesses at the interchanges may be affected, either because of a change in access or because their property will be acquired as part of this project. No residential relocations are anticipated.

Citizens and business owners are encouraged to attend the meeting to view the maps and ask questions. Please provide written comments by December 6. Following the meeting, the environmental document, an Environmental Assessment (EA) will be prepared.

Project Description

The purpose of replacing the bridges is to maintain safe, reliable structures for long term use. While the existing bridges are still adequate and safe for traffic, they are nearing the end of their design lives and need to be replaced in a timely manner.

Raleigh's *Capital Boulevard Corridor Study* and NCDOT's *Southeast High Speed Rail Project* are likely to affect the same section of Capital Boulevard as the bridge replacements. NCDOT has continued to coordinate closely with the City of Raleigh to ensure that the projects are consistent with each other, and to reduce the length and number of times the roadways need to be under construction.
