The North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) will hold a public meeting called a citizens' informational workshop on Thursday, July 26, 2012 from 4-7 p.m. in the Multi-Purpose Room of the New Century International Elementary School, located at 7465 Century Circle in Fayetteville.

The purpose of this meeting is for NCDOT representatives to provide information and answer questions regarding proposed improvements for the intersection of Galatia Church Road (State Road 1103) and Stoney Point Road (S.R. 1112) in Fayetteville. The opportunity to submit written comments will be provided. Interested citizens may attend at any time during the above mentioned hours. There will not be a formal presentation.

NCDOT proposes to create a dead end for Galatia Church Road before its intersection with Stoney Point Road. This will create a 3-way intersection instead of a cross-roads intersection. Access to Galatia Church Road would change from Stoney Point Road to Gillis Hill Road (S.R. 1102).
