The North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) will hold the above Citizens Informational Workshop on Monday, May 23, 2011 between the hours of 4:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. at the Newland Providence Ruritan Club Community Building, 999 US Highway 158 in Morgan's Corner, 27909.

Interested individuals may attend this informal workshop at their convenience during the above stated hours. Please note there will be no formal presentation.

The purpose of this workshop is for NCDOT representatives to provide information, answer questions, and to receive any information and/or comments from the public regarding this project. NCDOT proposes to widen US 158 from NC 32 in Sunbury to US 17 at Morgan's Corner. The project is about 16 miles long. Additional right of way will be required to accommodate the proposed improvements.
