The North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) will hold the above Public Informational Meeting on Monday, Jan. 30, 2012, between the hours of 5 and 7 p.m. in the Harnett County Governmental Complex – Commons Area, located at 311 Cornelius Harnett Boulevard in Lillington.

The purpose of this meeting is for NCDOT representatives to provide information, answer questions and receive comments regarding the proposed spot safety project at the U.S. 401 (Main Street) intersections with N.C. 27 (West Old Road) and West McNeill Street in Lillington. Citizens are invited to drop in anytime during the above hours. There will not be a formal presentation.

NCDOT proposes to improve the vehicle turning ability and traffic flow by installing a new traffic signal at the intersection of Main Street and West Old Road. Access from existing West McNeill Street onto Main Street will be closed and traffic will access Main Street via West Old Road at the new traffic signal. Several driveway accesses along Main Street, between East Northington Street and East McNeill Street will be closed, but there still will be access to existing businesses. These changes will improve vehicle, pedestrian and bicycle safety at these intersections.
