

NCDOT TO HOST PUBLIC MEETING JUNE 19 FOR PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS TO THE I-40 AND N.C.42 INTERCHANGE AND EVALUATION OF CLEVELAND ROAD (S.R. 1010) AND CORNWALLIS ROAD (S.R. 1525)

The [N.C. Department of Transportation](#) will hold a public meeting regarding proposed improvements to the I-40 and N.C. 42 interchange, including improvements to the Cleveland Road (S.R. 1010) and the Cornwallis Road (S.R. 1525) in Johnston County.

The meeting will take place on Thursday, June 19, at West View Elementary School, located at 11755 Cleveland Road, Garner from 4:00 pm to 7:00 p.m. Citizens are welcome to stop by at any time during the open-house hours; there will not be a formal presentation. NCDOT representatives will be available to answer questions and receive comments. Written comments or questions can also be submitted at the meeting or later by July 3, 2014.

The purpose of this meeting is to seek public input on several options for reducing traffic congestion at the I-40 / N.C. 42 interchange, including the area around Cornwallis Road (S.R.1525) on I-40 and Cleveland Road (S.R.1010). The purpose of the project is to increase mobility and reduce congestion. The need for the project is due to the substantial growth in the area and expected future traffic.
