

NOTICE OF A CITIZENS INFORMATIONAL WORKSHOP  
FOR IMPROVING VEHICULAR SAFETY AND TRAFFIC OPERATIONS  
IN FIVE LOCATIONS ALONG US 1 IN SANFORD

The North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) will hold the above Citizens Informational Workshop on Tuesday, April 12, 2011, between the hours of 4:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m., in the Dennis Wicker Civic Center (Main Hall), located at 1801 Nash Street, Sanford, 27330.

The purpose of this workshop-style public meeting is for NCDOT representatives to display maps, provide information, and answer questions relative to the project. **Please note: there will be a brief presentation of the project at 5:00 pm and 6:00 pm.** The opportunity to submit written comments will also be provided and is encouraged.

NCDOT proposes to make the following safety improvements along US 1 in Sanford, at the following five (5) locations:

- 1) Closure of the median crossover - at US 1's northernmost crossover with Westover Drive (SR 1333) and Keller Andrews Road (SR 1154)
- 2) Modify the existing full movement crossover to a two-direction "left-over" – at US 1 and the Tramway Crossing Shopping Center
- 3) Install a wireless, closed loop traffic signal system – on US 1 from NC 78 / Center Church Road (SR 1303) to Pendergrass Road (SR 1334)
- 4) Construct left turn lanes for northbound and southbound US 1 traffic and install yellow-flashing arrow signal heads for the left turn movements – at US 1 and Hickory House Road (SR 1157)
- 5) Construct left turn lanes for northbound and southbound US 1 traffic and install yellow-flashing arrow signal heads for the left turn movements – at US 1 / US 15-501 and Rocky Fork Church Road (SR 1179)

The proposed improvements will improve vehicular safety and traffic operations at the above-listed intersections along US 1 in Sanford.
