

**NCDOT TO HOLD A PUBLIC MEETING
FOR A ROAD / RAILROAD TRAFFIC SEPARATION STUDY (TSS) IN
MEBANE, ALAMANCE & ORANGE COUNTIES
WBS No. 32268**

The North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) will hold a Public Meeting for the railroad/road study which includes several public railroad crossings in Alamance and Orange. The meeting will be held on Tuesday, November 15, 2016 from 5 to 7 p.m. at the City of Mebane City Hall, 106 E. Washington Street, Mebane.

The purpose of the study is to ensure the safety of the motorists, bicyclists, pedestrians, rail passengers, train crews and the surrounding communities.

The purpose of this meeting is to discuss and receive public feedback on the usage of the following eight existing railroad crossings in Mebane to help develop preliminary recommendations for improvements/closures:

- Buckhorn Road
- Mattress Factory
- Fifth Street (N.C. 119)
- Fourth Street
- South Third Street
- Moore Road
- Lake Latham Road
- Gibson Road

Citizens are encouraged to provide comments and suggestions related to the crossings. NCDOT representatives will be present to provide information, and answer questions regarding this study. The opportunity to submit written comments will also be provided at the meeting or via phone, email or mail by December 15, 2016. Interested citizens may attend at any time during the above mentioned hours. Note: There will not be a formal presentation.
