

NOTICE OF A CITIZENS INFORMATIONAL WORKSHOP FOR PROPOSED
REVISIONS TO THE NC 211 WIDENING PROJECT
BETWEEN WEST END AND THE VILLAGE OF PINEHURST

The North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) will hold the above Citizens Informational Workshop on Tuesday, November 9, 2010, between the hours of 4:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. at the Village of Pinehurst - Assembly Hall, located at 395 Magnolia Road, in Pinehurst.

NCDOT representatives will be available in an informal, open-house setting to answer questions and receive comments about proposed revisions to the NC 211 widening project. The opportunity to submit written comments regarding the proposed revisions will be provided. Interested citizens may attend at any time during the above mentioned hours. Please note: there will be no formal presentation.

NCDOT plans to display design revisions that were made in 2 sections of the NC 211 widening project. The first section runs from east of Hoffman Road to west of Archie Road; and the second section runs from west of Stoneykirk Drive to east of NC 5 (Beulah Hill Road). The other sections of the project have not changed since the project was originally presented at the public hearing in April 2006. The proposed revisions call for shifting NC 211 to the south in both sections and constructing a "bulb-out" turnaround for oversize vehicles between Hoffman Road and Archie Road.
