The North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) will hold an informal Design Public Meeting on Tuesday, March 16, 2010, between the hours of 4 p.m. and 7 p.m. at the South Rocky Mount Community Center, located at 517 Ravenwood Drive in Rocky Mount.

NCDOT representatives will be available in an informal setting to answer questions and receive comments relative to the proposed project. The opportunity to submit written comments or questions will also be provided. Interested citizens may attend at any time during the above mentioned hours. There will not be a formal presentation.

NCDOT proposes to widen and include a turning lane on Kingston Avenue (State Road 1727) from N.C. 97 to U.S. 301 Business in Rocky Mount. The purpose of this project is to improve mobility and safety for both pedestrians and vehicles traveling along Kingston Avenue.

Additional right-of-way acquisition and the relocation of homes and businesses may be required for this project.
