The North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) will hold the above Citizens Informational Workshop on February 9, 2012, between the hours of 5 p.m. and 7 p.m. at WH Robinson Elementary School, 2439 Railroad Street, Winterville, 28590.

Maps depicting the proposed project will be on display and NCDOT representatives will be available in an informal setting to answer questions and receive comments regarding the proposed project. The opportunity to submit written comments or questions will also be provided. Interested citizens may attend at any time during the above mentioned hours. Please note: there will not be a formal presentation.

NCDOT proposes the closure of the Boyd Street and the CSX Railroad at-grade crossing #641 624K. The proposed closure of this at-grade highway/rail crossing is part of an effort to reduce the number of redundant and/or unsafe highway/rail at-grade crossings statewide. The Worthington Street crossing about 750 feet north of the proposed closure has flashers and gates as a crossing warning device.
