The North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) will hold the above Citizens Informational Workshop on Thursday, December 8, 2011 between the hours of 4 p.m. and 7 p.m. in Forrest Hunt Elementary School Cafeteria located at 100 Forrest W. Hunt Drive, Forest City.

Interested individuals may attend this informal workshop any time during the between 4 p.m. and 7 p.m. NCDOT representatives will display maps and be available to answer questions and receive comments. Please note that there will not be a formal presentation.

NCDOT proposes to transportation improvements to US 221 ALT from Main Street (S.R. 1920) in Henrietta to Melton Street (S.R. 1941) in Caroleen. The primary purpose of the project is to improve the alignment and maintenance conditions of US 221A between Avondale and Caroleen. Other beneficial outcomes could include an improvement in the safety of the roadway, as well as a more efficient flow of traffic. The project is about 1.0 mile long. Additional right of way and the relocation homes and businesses may be required for construction.
