

NCDOT TO HOLD PUBLIC MEETING JULY 8 FOR THE PROPOSED SAFETY IMPROVEMENT ON CARVER STREET (S.R. 1407) AT THE INTERSECTION OF BROAD STREET AND KENAN ROAD IN DURHAM

Spot Safety Project No. SS-4905BM

The [N.C. Department of Transportation](#) will hold a public meeting regarding a proposed safety project for the construction of a mini-roundabout on Carver Street (S.R. 1407) at the intersection of Broad Street and Kenan Road in Durham, Durham County.

The proposed mini-roundabout is expected to improve the safety and operations at this intersection. The purpose of this project is to address the pattern of crashes that have occurred at this location. The project will require the acquisition of some additional easements. All information along with the maps will be available at the meeting.

The meeting will take place on Tuesday, July 8 from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. at Staff Development Center, Durham Public Schools, 2107 Hillandale Road, Durham. NCDOT representatives will be available to answer questions and receive comments regarding the proposed project.
