
The public is invited to attend a Project Update Meeting for the Southeast High Speed Rail Project.

In the summer of 2010, the North Carolina Department of Transportation Rail Division (NCDOT) and the Virginia Department of Rail and Public Transportation (DRPT) held a series of Public Hearings on a Draft Tier II Environmental Impact Statement (DEIS) for the Richmond, VA, to Raleigh, NC, portion of the SEHSR corridor. The SEHSR project proposes to implement approximately 162 miles of high speed rail as part of an overall plan to extend high speed passenger rail service from the Northeast Corridor (Boston, MA, to Washington, DC) southward through Virginia to Charlotte, NC.

In response to public comments on the DEIS, revisions were made to proposed bridges and underpasses, rail crossing closures and other roadwork throughout the corridor, including modifications at the following locations in downtown Wake Forest and north Raleigh:

- Elm Avenue underpass
- Steeple Run Drive
- Durant Road bridge realignment
- New Hope Church Road
- Wolfpack Lane
