Public Meeting to be held

The N.C. Department of Transportation will hold an informal project update meeting to inform the community on the progress of the Salem Creek Connector Project, which is currently under construction, and to explain what to expect in the future.


NCDOT is constructing a new 1.1-mile, four-lane road with a median from Martin Luther King Jr. Drive south of Winston-Salem State University to Rams Drive (formerly Stadium Drive) at the Wake Forest Innovation Quarter. The nearly \$69 million project started in December 2013 and should be completed by summer of 2016.

Citizens may stop by at their convenience; there will **not** be a formal presentation. Maps will be available to review and NCDOT representatives will be available to answer questions and receive comments.
