The North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) will hold the above Citizens Informational Workshop on Monday, February 8, 2010 between the hours of 5:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. in the cafeteria of Walter Bickett Elementary School, located at 830 South Martin Luther King Boulevard, Monroe.

Maps depicting the proposed project will be on display and NCDOT representatives will be available in an informal setting to answer questions and receive comments regarding the proposed project. The opportunity to submit written comments or questions will also be provided. Interested citizens may attend at any time during the above mentioned hours. Please note: there will not be a formal presentation.

NCDOT proposes the closure of the Elizabethan Road (SR 1176) at-grade highway / rail crossing (Crossing #638 864N) located on the CSX Railroad near Monroe. The proposed closure of this at-grade rail crossing is part of an effort to reduce the number of redundant and / or unsafe rail-highway at-grade crossings statewide.
