

**NOTICE OF A PUBLIC MEETING FOR THE PAVEMENT
REHABILITATION OF I-40 / US 64 / I-440 BETWEEN US 1/64 AND THE
KNIGHTDALE BYPASS (US 64) IN RALEIGH**

TIP Project No. I-5338 / I-5311

Wake County

The North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) will hold a public meeting on Thursday, July 19, 2012, from 3–7 p.m. at the Wake County Commons Building, located at 4011 Cary Drive, in Raleigh.

NCDOT proposes to address deteriorating pavement conditions by replacing the existing road base and pavement on I-40 / US 64 / I-440 (commonly known as the southern portion of the beltline) from west of the Jones Franklin Road (State Road 1319) overpass to just north of US 264 (Exit 14, Knightdale Bypass).

NCDOT also proposes to add lanes to connect ramps between various interchanges along the project to help ease congestion.

Right-of-way acquisition is not anticipated, as proposed improvements are expected to be performed within existing NCDOT right-of-way.

Maps will be on display depicting the project construction area. NCDOT representatives will be available to answer questions. The opportunity to provide written comments will be provided and is encouraged. Citizens may drop in any time during the public meeting hours. There will not be a formal presentation.

This public meeting is being held to provide the public an opportunity to participate in the planning process. Comments and information obtained from the public will be taken into consideration as work on these projects progress. Extensive public outreach will be conducted throughout the project to keep people informed. There is a possibility that traffic may be reduced to only two travel lanes in either direction for a period of three years.
