YOUR COMMENTS MATTER!

The North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) and the Virginia Department of Rail and Public Transportation have completed a Draft Tier II Environmental Impact Statement for the Richmond, VA, to Raleigh, NC, portion of the Southeast High Speed Rail (SEHSR) corridor. The SEHSR project proposes to implement approximately 162 miles of high speed rail as part of an overall plan to extend high speed passenger rail service from the Northeast Corridor (Boston to Washington, DC) southward through Virginia to Charlotte, NC. Public comments will be used to help determine the preferred alternative in the Richmond to Raleigh section.

Stop by the "open house" anytime between 5:00 and 7:00 pm to learn about the rail and road designs that are proposed as part of this project. Provide your comments at the formal hearing at 7:00 pm, complete the online comment form on the project website, or mail your comments to: SEHSR Comments, NCDOT Rail Division, 1553 MSC, Raleigh, NC 27699-1553. Comments will be accepted until August 30, 2010.
