THE PROPOSED CLOSURE OF SR 1635 (BRICK KILN ROAD) AT-GRADE
HIGHWAY / RAIL CROSSING NEAR VANCEBORO

The North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) will hold the above Citizens Informational Workshop on Tuesday, March 15, 2011, between the hours of 5:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. in the cafeteria of West Craven High School, located at 2600 Streets Ferry Road, Vanceboro.

Maps depicting the proposed project will be on display and NCDOT representatives will be available in an informal setting to answer questions and receive comments regarding the proposed project. The opportunity to submit written comments or questions will also be provided. Interested citizens may attend at any time during the above mentioned hours. Please note: there will not be a formal presentation.

NCDOT proposes the closure of the Brick Kiln Road (SR 1635) at-grade highway / rail crossing (Crossing #466 097M, MP NB15.89), near Vanceboro. The Brick Kiln Road highway/rail crossing is on a gravel road with an Average Daily Traffic count of 60 vehicles per day. The proposed closure and relocation of these at-grade rail crossings is part of an effort to reduce the number of redundant and / or unsafe rail-highway at-grade crossings statewide.
