The North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) will hold two informal public meetings regarding the proposed improvements to I-85 from U.S. 158 (milepost 213.5) in Vance County to the Virginia state line.

The purpose of this project is to address the deteriorating pavement conditions and improve operations and safety through rehabilitation and/or replacement. The project will also improve vertical clearance of the bridges.

The meetings will be held from 5 until 7:00 p.m. in an open house format.
