The North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) will hold the above Citizens Informational Workshop on Tuesday, November 30, 2010, between the hours of 5:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. at the Middlesex Town Hall, 10232 South Nash Street, Middlesex, 27557

Maps depicting the proposed project will be on display and NCDOT representatives will be available in an informal setting to answer questions and receive comments regarding the proposed project. The opportunity to submit written comments or questions will also be provided. Interested citizens may attend at any time during the above mentioned hours. Please note: there will not be a formal presentation.

NCDOT proposes the closure of the SR 1108 (Stone Heritage Road) at-grade highway / Carolina Coastal Railway crossing #465 637C. The crossing is on an unpaved road with estimated 2008 year traffic of 79 vehicles per day. SR1100 (Camp Charles Road) railroad crossing is located approximately 1.143 miles east of the proposed closure. It provides adequate alternate access using signals and gate arms as a crossing warning device. The proposed closure of this at-grade rail crossing is part of an effort to reduce the number of redundant and / or unsafe rail-highway at-grade crossings statewide.
