

NCDOT TO HOLD PUBLIC MEETING JAN 29 FOR THE PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS  
TO NC 225 (GREENVILLE HIGHWAY) AT THE INTERSECTIONS OF SR 1164 (ERKWOOD DRIVE)  
AND SR 1779 (SHEPHERD STREET)

The N. C. Department of Transportation will hold a public meeting regarding the proposed project to improve the existing roadway network including the intersections of NC 225 (Greenville Highway) with SR 1164 (Erkwood Drive) and SR 1779 (Shepherd Street) in Hendersonville.

The meeting will take place on **Thursday, January 29**, at the **Village of Flat Rock, Village Hall** located at **110 Village Center Drive** from **4:00 to 7:00 p.m.** Interested citizens may attend at any time during the meeting hours, as there will be no formal presentation. NCDOT representatives will be available to answer questions and listen to comments regarding the project. Citizens will also have the opportunity to submit comments and questions in writing. Comments received will be taken into consideration as the project develops.

The purpose of the project is to improve the existing roadway network and to realign SR 1164 (Erkwood Drive) and SR 1779 (Shepherd Street) to create a four-leg intersection with NC 225 (Greenville Highway). In doing this, a more direct east-west connection will be formed for the area south of Hendersonville.
