

## **Public Meeting September 30 for proposed improvements on I-95 Business/U.S. 301 in Cumberland County**

Raleigh - The [N.C. Department of Transportation](#) will hold an informal public meeting at the end of the month regarding proposed improvements on I-95 Business/ U.S. 301 highway from N.C. 87 to N.C. 59 in Fayetteville.

The meeting will take place on Tuesday, September 30, from 5 until 7 p.m. at the Cumberland County School District Office Boardroom, 2465 Gillespie Street in Fayetteville.

Citizens are welcome to stop by at any time during the meeting hours, as there will not be a formal presentation. NCDOT representatives will be available to answer questions and receive comments. Written comments or questions can be submitted at the meeting or by October 14.

NCDOT proposes to redesign and implement safety improvements on this section of I-95 Business/U.S. 301 in order to make the highway more effective in handling the traffic volume. The proposal includes limiting movement crossovers with U-turns, traffic control revisions, cul-de-sac installations, intersection improvements and realignment.
