

**PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS TO U.S. 74 BETWEEN
INDIAN TRAIL-FAIRVIEW ROAD AND WESLEY CHAPEL
STOUTS ROAD / SARDIS CHURCH ROAD IN INDIAN TRAIL IN UNION COUNTY**

The N.C. Department of Transportation will hold an informal public meeting regarding proposed improvements to U.S. 74 between Indian Trail-Fairview Road and Wesley Chapel Stouts Road / Sardis Church Road.

The meeting will take place on November 13, from 4:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m. at the Indian Trail Civic Building, 100 Navajo Trail, Indian Trail, NC, 28079.

The purpose of this meeting is for NCDOT representatives to provide information and answer questions regarding the proposed transportation improvements to U.S. 74. The opportunity to submit written comments will be provided at the meeting or by December 1 to the provided contact information. Interested citizens may attend at any time during the above mentioned hours. Note: There will be no formal presentation.

The purpose of this project is to convert this section of U.S. 74 to a superstreet configuration. A superstreet is a type of intersection in which side-street traffic is redirected from going straight through or left at a divided highway intersection. All side-street traffic must turn right, but can then access a U-turn to proceed in the desired direction. All full movement, signalized intersections along U.S. 74 between Indian Trail-Fairview Road and Wesley Chapel Stouts Road / Sardis Church Road will be converted to a superstreet configuration. Superstreets increase safety and efficiency at intersections by reducing the number of conflict points.
