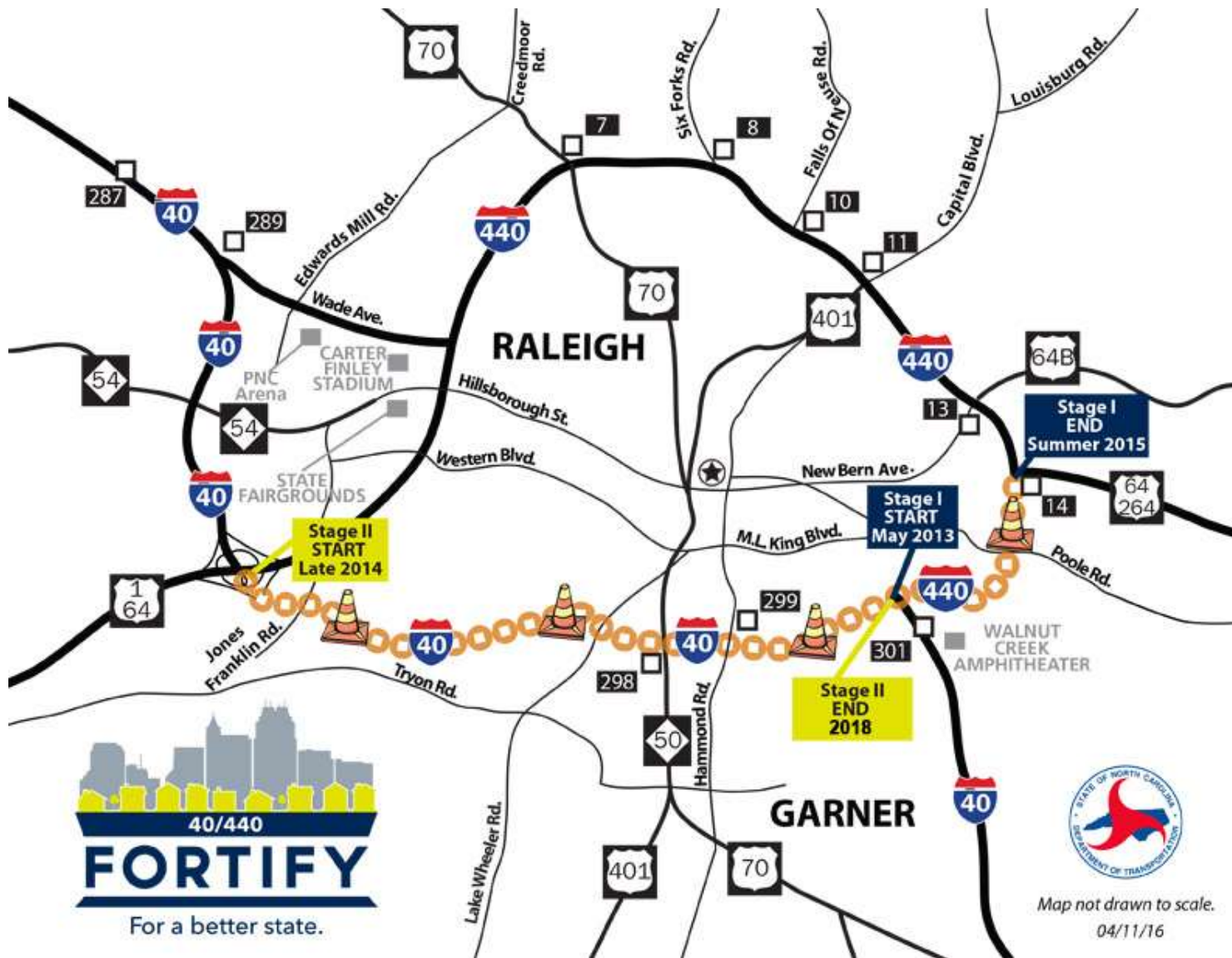




## *Why Fortify?*

- Thirty-year-old pavement was cracking and crumbling because of a chemical reaction happening underneath the road, triggered by a substance used in paving several decades ago.
- Crews are rebuilding an 11.5-mile stretch of I-40 and I-440.



# *Major Fortification*

- **Replace pavement** along 11.5-mile stretch of southern stretch of I-40 / I-440
- **Extend the lanes** between ramps in each direction at:
  - U.S.1/64 (Exit 293)/Gorman Street (Exit 295)
  - Gorman Street (Exit 295)/Lake Wheeler Road (Exit 297)
- **Extend deceleration lane** – off ramp for Rock Quarry Road (Exit 300B)
- **Rehabilitate 14 bridges** within project zone

## *NCDOT Helping Ease the Pain*

- Keeping three lanes open in both directions for most of the project – during the entire I-40 rebuild.
- Investing an additional \$12 million in public transportation to add more buses and routes as well as identifying new park-and-ride options.

## *We Need Your Help*

To help reduce congestion, the goal is to get 30,000 cars off the road during heavy commute times.
