Media Form Instructions for Litter Sweep Volunteer Groups

1. Enter the name of the media organization in blank (1).
2. Enter the date of the news release.
3. Enter your group's contact information in the Contact Information of Litter Sweep Volunteer Group section at the top of the news release.
4. Enter the city or town of your group in blank (2) of the news release.
5. Enter your group name in blank (3) of the news release.
6. Enter the date of your Litter Sweep cleanup event in blank (4) of the news release.
7. Enter the meeting place of your cleanup in blank (5) of the news release.
8. Enter the group contact person in blank (6) and contact information in blank (7) of the news release.
9. Complete the Details of our Upcoming Litter Sweep Event section with all necessary information. If possible, attach a map of the meet up and cleanup locations.
10. Distribute your news release to desired local media organizations.
