

**Statement of Intent**  
**For North Carolina Department of Transportation Public Transportation Division**  
**Apprenticeship and Intern Programs**

The Statement of Intent is an essay that applicants submit as part of the application for the Apprenticeship or Intern position. The statement provides more than the details that can be found on the applicant's resume. It addresses the applicant's purpose for applying to the program, the unique personal assets that the applicant brings to the program specifically and to the public transportation industry in general. The statement should be at least one full page, not to exceed two pages, single-spaced. The Statement of Intent will be used as part of the criteria for selecting successful applicants to the program.

**Write a candid description of yourself, stressing those personal qualities, assets, and liabilities that you feel will influence your work. Describe what you consider your most important professional, academic or personal achievement to date. The essay must specifically address the following questions:**

*What are the specific skills, knowledge and abilities that you can bring to the NCDOT/PTD Apprentice (Intern) program?*

*What do you hope to achieve as a result of your participation in the program?*

**NOTE: Include a brief statement at the bottom of the essay stating where in North Carolina you wish to be placed (Please indicate 1st and 2nd choice for the county, city, region).**
