NCDMV Appointment Confirmation

To combat people not showing up for their scheduled appointments at driver license offices, the N.C. Division of Motor Vehicles is now requiring new appointments to be confirmed.

Now, when appointments are reserved online at SkipTheLine.ncdot.gov, customers will immediately receive a text message and email with a confirmation link and will have 15 minutes to respond.

Four days before the appointment, customers will receive a reminder

Old Manns Harbor Bridge to Close Temporarily in Mid-May

The William B. Umstead (Old Manns Harbor) Bridge on U.S. 64 over Croatan Sound in Dare County will be closing in the second half of May for an estimated six months as a \$33 million bridge preservation project enters a critical phase.



During the closure, all 313 concrete spans on the bridge will be repaired and each of the 170 expansion joints will be replaced. Given the extent of the restoration work and the narrow lanes on the 69-year-old bridge, the N.C. Department of Transportation has determined that a complete bridge closure is preferable to completing the work under single lane closures.
