May is National Youth Traffic Safety, Motorcycle Safety Awareness Month and National Bicycle Safety Month.



Bladen County Bridge Requires Closures for Girder Placements

ELIZABETHTOWN – The U.S. 701 bridge over the Cape Fear River is closing twice a day this month for the next phase of construction. A state contractor has set up a <u>massive</u> <u>crane that is setting girders</u> into place on the new bridge. The girders must be offloaded onto the existing bridge, necessitating the closures. The bridge will close most weekdays from 9-10 a.m. and from 2-3 p.m.

Trio of Columbus County Intersections Being Revamped

CHADBOURN – Work will start this month on improving the safety and traffic flow at three Columbus County intersections in the same vicinity. The project by the N.C. Department of Transportation involves realigning <u>Old Lumberton Road at N.C. 410</u>, and making other improvements to nearby intersections.
