### [Fayetteville Outer Loop Extended to I-95](#)

**HOPE MILLS** – Travel south of Fayetteville became easier Wednesday, after another section of Interstate 295 opened to traffic.

Contractors for the N.C. Department of Transportation removed the barrels and barricades Wednesday afternoon, partially opening the [Camden Road interchange \(Exit 7\)](#) outside Hope Mills.

"Today marks another milestone toward the completion of the Fayetteville Outer Loop," said Grady Hunt, a member of the N.C. Board of Transportation who lives in Robeson County. "This is a critical corridor for our region of the state, for Fort Liberty and for continued economic growth and better highway access."
