May is National Youth Traffic Safety, Motorcycle Safety Awareness Month and National Bicycle Safety Month.

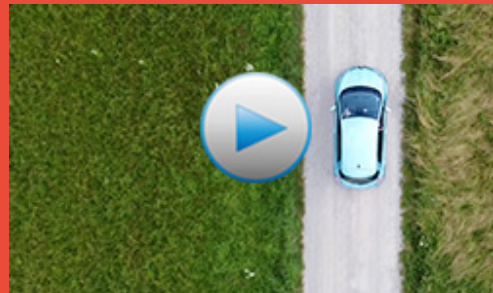

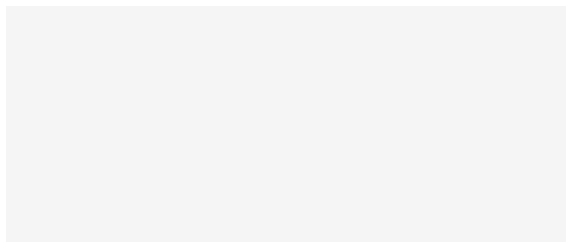
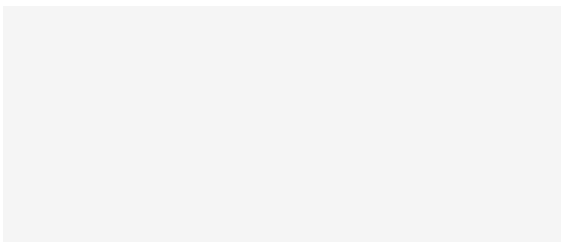
