Division 14 Crews Prepare for Winter Weather



Preparing for weather emergencies is one of NCDOT's major responsibilities.

Crews in all 100 counties are conducting drills to make sure equipment is working correctly and that drivers are familiar with snow routes. They will also assess the supplies of salt and sand which are essential during snow and ice removal. Teams from each county in Division 14 completed pre-season dry-runs and inspections in October.

Do you know the department can store up to 170,000 tons (about the weight of 34,000 African elephants) of salt and sand, and more than 500,000 gallons of brine at maintenance facilities statewide?
