

**NCDOT TO HOLD PUBLIC MEETING FOR THE PROPOSED  
GRADE SEPARATION AT THE CORNWALLIS ROAD (S.R. 1121)  
RAIL CROSSING IN DURHAM COUNTY**

The N.C. Department of Transportation will hold a public meeting regarding the proposed grade separation at the Cornwallis Road (S.R. 1121) rail crossing of the Norfolk Southern and N.C. Railroad line in Durham County. The purpose of this project is to improve operations and safety at the crossing.

The meeting will be held on **Tuesday, December 11, 2018** at **The Frontier** located at **800 Park Offices Drive** in **Research Triangle Park** from **5-7 p.m.** Interested citizens may attend at any time during the meeting hours. Please note there will be no formal presentation.

At the meeting there will be maps of the proposed plans as well as project team members who will be available to answer questions and receive comments regarding the project. All comments will be taken into consideration as the project progresses. The opportunity to submit written comments will be provided at the meeting or can be done via phone, email, or mail no later than **January 1, 2019**.
