The N.C. Department of Transportation is proposing to widen U.S. 17 from Antioch Rd (S.R. 1433) to Spruill Town Rd (S.R. 1438). The project was submitted to the State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) by the Down East Regional Planning Organization (DERPO). The project is between the Towns of Vanceboro and Bridgeton in Craven County. The NCDOT has developed a design concept for the project.
