The N.C. Department of Transportation is proposing to make improvements to the intersection of U.S. 64/N.C. 280 (Asheville Highway) and U.S. 64/U.S. 276 (Hendersonville Highway/Pisgah Highway) in the City of Brevard.

A public meeting to present the options being proposed and obtain feedback will be held at the **Transylvania County Library** located at **212 S. Gaston Street**, in **Brevard**, on Thursday, May 24th from **4:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.**

Interested citizens may attend at any time between 4:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. Please note that a short presentation will be made at 5:00 p.m. NCDOT representatives will display maps and be available to answer questions and receive comments.
