The N.C. Department of Transportation will hold a public meeting regarding the proposed improvements to U.S. 19/129 from the Georgia state line to U.S. 64/74 in Cherokee County. The purpose of the project is to improve traffic flow and safety along the U.S. 19/129 roadway.
