

**NCDOT TO HOLD PUBLIC MEETING
FOR THE PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS TO MCCRIMMON PARKWAY (S.R. 1635)
FROM DAVIS DRIVE (S.R. 1613) TO PERIMETER PARK DRIVE
AND GRADE SEPARATION OVER N.C. 54 (CHAPEL HILL ROAD) AND RAILROAD
WAKE COUNTY**

The N.C. Department of Transportation will hold a public meeting regarding the proposed project to improve McCrimmon Parkway (S.R. 1635) from west of Davis Drive (S.R. 1613) to Perimeter Park Drive. The project also proposes to build a grade separation over N.C. 54 (Chapel Hill Road) and the railroad in Morrisville. The meeting will take place on Thursday, November 8, 2018 from 4 p.m. to 7 p.m. at the Hope Community Church, Morrisville Campus located at 1000 Perimeter Park Drive in Morrisville.

The purpose of this project is to reduce congestion along McCrimmon Parkway from west of Davis Drive to Perimeter Park Drive. Another purpose is to improve safety along this corridor by building a grade separation over N.C. 54 and the railroad.

The public may drop-in at any time during the meeting hours. NCDOT representatives will be available to answer questions and listen to comments regarding the project. The opportunity to submit comments will also be provided at the meeting or via phone, email, or mail by November 30, 2018. Comments received will be taken into consideration as the project develops. Please note that no formal presentation will be made.
